

 - Add language to address specific needs



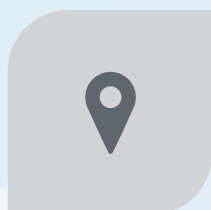

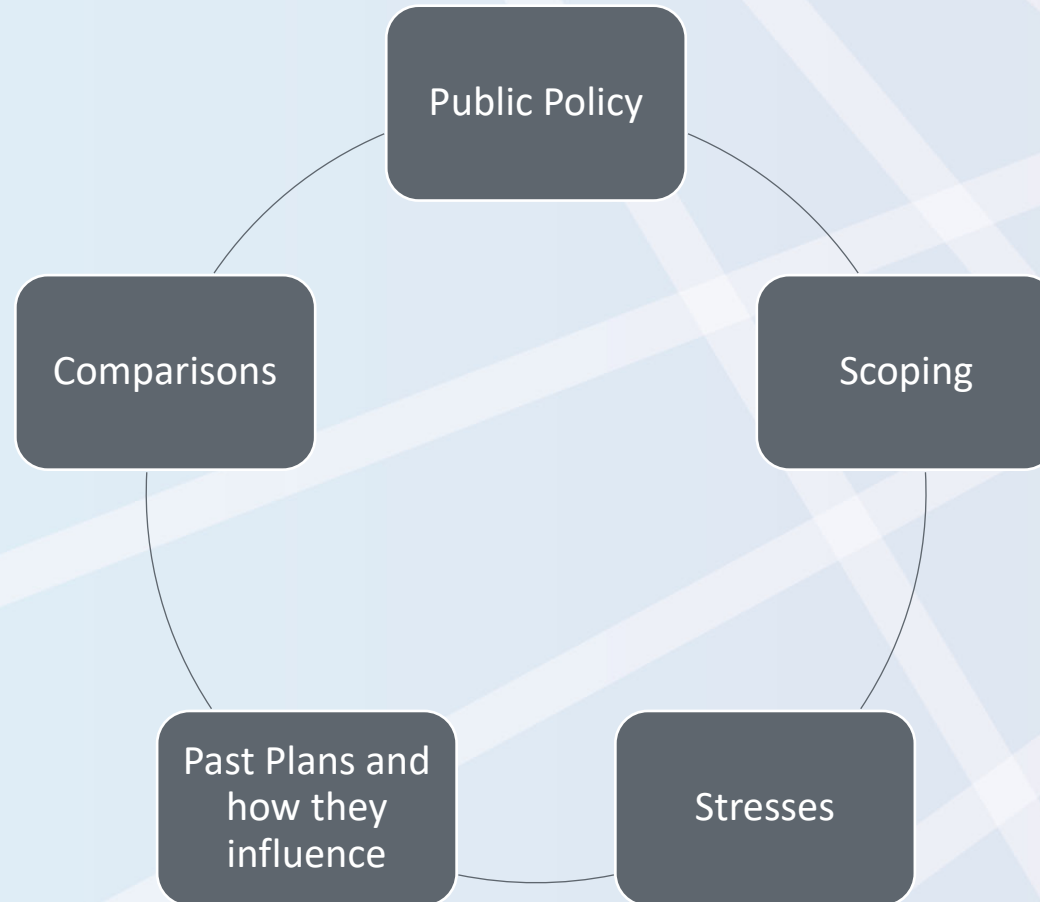
